- Launched in **2005** by U.S. EPA and NESCAUM
- Regional clean transportation partnership to reduce diesel emissions and improve air quality
- New England States, New York, New Jersey, Puerto Rico and Virgin Islands
- Partners spanning diverse modes of transportation marine, railroad, truck and off road (construction and cargo handling)
- Mission to raise awareness, prioritize activities, seek funding and take action in the Northeast

#### A Multi-Stakeholder Partnership

Promote effective coordination across Northeastern states to plan for and develop clean freight corridors to advance high-efficiency, low-emission alternative transportation technologies across all modes.



#### **NECFC Goals for 2018/19**

- Collaborate with Clean Cities Coalitions on corridor-based fueling and best applications for alt fuel freight vehicles and infrastructure
- Help identify & prioritize Northeast gaps in FHWA-designated alt fuel corridors for building infrastructure; coordinate with other Collaboratives, I-95 Corridor Coalition for Eastern seaboard approach
- Learn from industry clean freight experts about advances in vehicle technologies and technology adoption
- Engage with TCI to track policy efforts to curtail transportation emissions
- Perform outreach via AltWheels, webinars, 2019 Partners Meeting, 2019
